

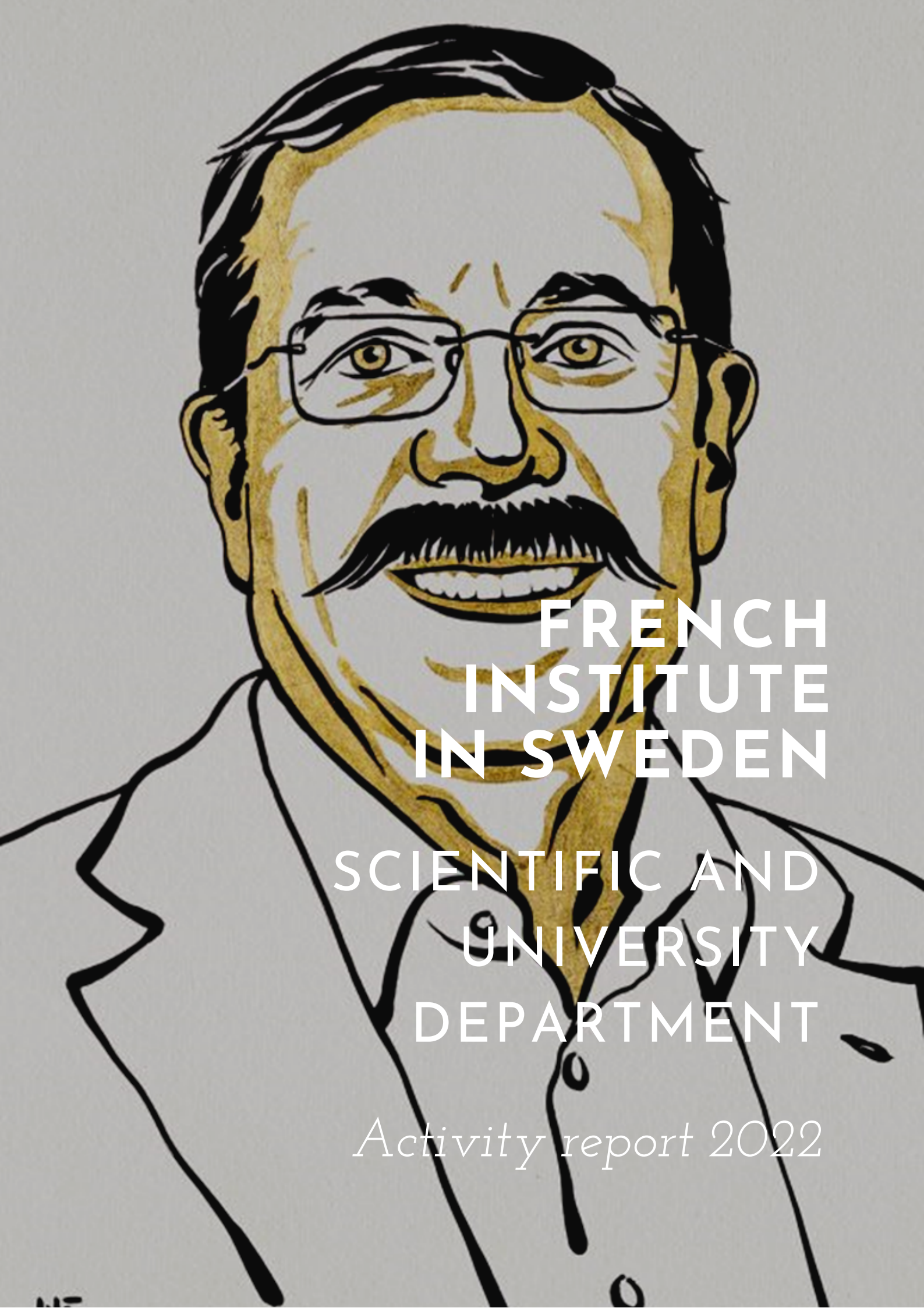

## Tour de Suède 2022



In April 2022, the French Institute in Sweden launched the *Tour de Suède*, in order to reach a wider audience across Sweden. The first edition took place from April 25 to May 11. The French Institute in Sweden met students in 12 cities in the south of Sweden: Stockholm, Örebro, Karlstad, Göteborg, Borås, Halmstad, Malmö, Lund, Karlskrona, Växjö, Jönköping and Linköping. Le *Tour de Suède* will take place every year, alternating between the south and the north part of the country.

During the *Tour de Suède* the French Institute in Sweden organized numerous events to promote higher education, research, the French language and French culture. The program includes visits to schools and universities, information sessions on studying in France, alumni events, French cinema events, debates and much more.

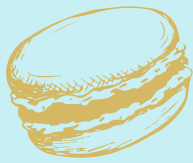
## European Universities conference

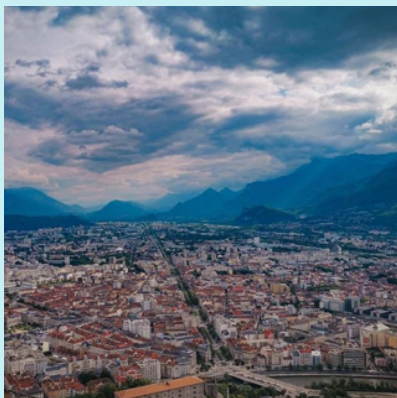
Students from Sweden came to France to study in the academic year 2020/2021.

## Nordic Campus France photo contest



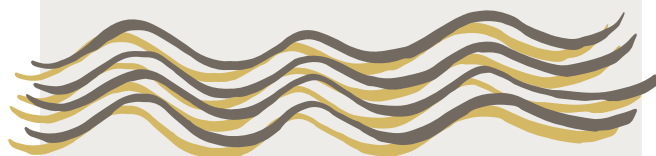

## FINA award: Marine studies



Anna Lunde Hermansson, PhD student at Chalmers University is the winner of the French Institutes Nordic Award 2022 for Sweden. She presented her research project "shipping challenges the endurance of the sea" at the French Residence in May. Then, Anna participated in the FINA webinar "Threats to our oceans – a global issue" with the other FINA laureates for the European Researchers' Night. The award was a scientific trip in France to participate in the SeaTechWeek and meet research teams from IFREMER, IUEM, SHOM, Campus Mondial de la Mer, Pôle mer Bretagne Atlantique, EMBRC and Ambassador for the Poles and Maritime issues.

## French Swedish Research Days - Textile Design



For the 25th edition, the French Institute in Sweden, in partnership with the University of Borås, organized a conference to discuss challenges facing the textile industry, alternative fibres and textile materials, smart textiles, the manufacture of tomorrow's textiles and the circular economy in the textile sector, in October at the Textile Fashion Center (Borås). 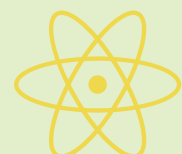
## NUIT DES IDÉES
