

Annex / Terms and Conditions

1. Organisers of the contest: French Institutes in Denmark, Finland, Norway and Sweden, and Interrail EU.
2. Participation is limited to individuals of a minimum of 18 years of age, who are citizens or residents of Sweden, studying in a Swedish institution of higher education, and spending part of the academic year 2024/2025 in France for an Erasmus+ mobility.
3. To participate, it is necessary to fill the online application form available on the website of the French Institute in Sweden before February 28 at 23:59, including the following information:
 - Full name
 - Email address
 - Age
 - Country
 - Home university / education institution
 - Area of studies
 - Destination institution of higher education in France
 - Type of Erasmus+ mobility (exchange, internship)
 - Their answer to the question "What are your motivations for preferring to travel by train?" among the following options (selecting all that apply):
 - a. Environmental sustainability
 - b. Comfort and convenience
 - c. Scenic views and sightseeing
 - d. Cost-effectiveness
 - e. Cultural experience and meeting new people
 - f. Other : [including a description]and upload
 - A proof of Swedish citizenship or residency in Sweden
 - A proof of participation to an Erasmus+ mobility in a French institution during the academic year 2024/2025
 - A photo or a short video or a text showcasing their preparation for their Erasmus+ stay in France, their view on mobility and excitement to discover the country.
4. The French Institute in Sweden, Denmark, Norway, and Finland will then select six winners who will each receive an Interrail Pass.
5. The winners commit to posting on their Instagram account a "postcard from France", i.e. a post or series of posts sharing their academic and cultural experiences in France including the hashtag #MyGreenErasmusinFrance and tagging the Instagram accounts of Campus France Sweden Sweden (@campusfrancesverige) and Interrail EU (@interrailleu). It is recommended that they highlight their train trips and the destinations visited with their Interrail Pass, and let their creativity shine.

6. By participating in the contest, the contestants allow the organisers to use their content on their social media and website, crediting the author of the content. The contributions that are shared in the course of this contest will be used in communication on social media and websites of the organisers within the framework of the contest. The organisers can also use the content in future events and on social media, in their mission to promote higher education in France.
7. Beyond the preceding provisions, and in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679, the personal data of participants will be processed solely for the purposes of this contest and future communications related to Campus France Sweden and Eurail. This data will be stored securely and will not be shared with third parties without the participants' explicit consent. Participants have the right to access, rectify, or delete their personal data at any time by contacting the organisers.
8. By participating in this contest, participants agree to the terms and conditions outlined by Campus France Denmark and Eurail. These include but are not limited to the eligibility criteria, the selection process, and the use of your personal data as described above.
